

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


Student support system at NIEPA




- 2 Somewhat dissatisfied

Feedback Analysis and Action Plan

The Institution obtained feedback from- Parents/ Guardians, Students, and Alumni on various aspects, such as Curricular aspects- library facilities and functioning, inter and intra institutional activities, Student cell, Counselling services, collaborative activities, placement cell, internships, cultural space, etc. The feedback obtained was analyzed and subsequent measures for the betterment of the students and the institutions were suggested.

The following report contains feedback analysis along with the actions taken by the IQAC:

Curricular aspects- Feedback Analysis and Action Plan

The curricular aspects include all the activities undertaken by the institution such as courses offered, facilities provided for academic and extracurricular activities, Hostel and canteen facilities, different services for students such as Student cell, Counselling services and placement cell, etc. Feedback from Parents/ Guardians, Students, and Alumni, pertaining to curricular aspects has been analyzed and action taken to improve the services have been mentioned as follows:

Parent/ Guardian's Feedback

Analysis: The Institute collected various details about the curricular aspects through the parent's feedback form. The responses received can be categorized from 'Good' to 'Excellent' on the basis of the analysis done. This shows that the Curriculum provided at NIEPA is at par with the standards laid down by UGC. The majority of the parents are satisfied with the services provided by NIEPA. For instance, 93% of parents are satisfied with the process of admission, 79% of parents are satisfied with the timely disbursement of the fellowship by the institution, and 75% of parents are satisfied with the campus facilities provided at the NIEPA campus. Yet there are some improvements to be made for the betterment of the institution.

Action plan: IQAC has taken the following measures to provide better services:

i) Library Facilities: Parents expressed the need for 24*7 Library Facilities and Online access to the library for their ward. For the last two years, the library was partly closed due to Covid 19 restrictions imposed by the government. The Library services have resumed post-covid restrictions and the opening hours have been restored from 9 am to 5:30 pm, also the students, researchers, and faculty, members of NIEPA have been provided access to both offline and online journals through 24x7 hours of VPN access.

ii) Hostel Facilities: Guardians expressed the need for a hostel facility for their ward studying in the institution. Due to Covid restrictions, the hostel facilities were suspended for students. Gradually, as Institute is opening, all the students have been offered a 15-days residential hostel facility and discussion with the private providers like OYO rooms is underway to explore the possibility to extend the hostel facility to all the scholars.

iii) Canteen Facilities: The guardians want better canteen facilities as revealed by them in their feedback. The Canteen facility is provided to everyone in NIEPA, post- covid restrictions these facilities are continuously monitored to offer better services in order to satisfy the needs of the students.

iv) Intra- institutional activities: The Guardians want more teacher-student interaction through intra- institutional activities. Therefore, IQAC will facilitate the transition from online seminar mode to blended academic interactions. However, more programmes are being contemplated to increase student-teacher interaction in consultation with concerned department units. Consequently, activities such as study- circles, cultural activities, and sports activities will be resumed and strengthened after post- covid restrictions.

v) Inter-institutional activities: The Guardians want more inter-institutional activities for their ward. Although, the students are provided with the opportunity to participate in different seminars, conferences and other academic activities organized by NIEPA or in collaboration with other institutions. Viewing the demands of the parents, Inter-institutional events will be further intensified for the students, post- covid restrictions. Presently, a no. of Webinars are also being conducted, where a large no. of students across Universities are participating.

vi) Student Cell: The parents have expressed the need for a more active student cell for their ward at NIEPA, therefore, IQAC meetings with the student cell are being planned to strengthen it.

vii) Counselling services: The guardians have expressed their need for a Counselling cell through the feedback. Although counselling already exists, viewing the demand, it will be further strengthened to offer better counselling services.

viii) Vacations: The parents have expressed the need for Vacations (summer and winter) for students. NIEPA provides appropriate no. of vacations and offers each scholar 30days of annual leave.

ix) Student -Exchange programmes: The parents have suggested that NIEPA should introduce study-abroad/international student exchange, therefore, IQAC will explore the possibilities of MoUs.

x) Experience: The parents have expressed that the students should be provided with Teaching experience/research project experience for students after completion of their programme; practical knowledge. The students are provided with the opportunity to participate in different seminars and workshops, conferences, and other academic activities at NIEPA or in collaboration with other institutions. However, the students will be encouraged to further strengthen their work.

xi) Guardian meet: The parents expressed that the Guardian meet may be organised through an online mode at a particular time interval. NIEPA is proposing to organize a no. of activities during the year. The parents are also intended invitees for all the events. Such as Convocation day, and Celebration of 60yrs.of NIEPA, Education day, etc.

xii) Cultural Space: The parents want NIEPA to develop a cultural space for interaction within NIEPA and with other universities. Student participation will be encouraged in several events organized at NIEPA such as the Celebration of Hindi Pakhwada, where poetry, essay competition, etc. are organized.
